Amy gave the Directors Report and updated members on the FY 2020 budget process, the Commission approved letter over the City Manager's signature was sent to legislators. The State approved a 3-year award of \$9800/year to support multicultural programs. The lease for a new tenant, Prime Movement LLC, has been finalized. Amy was contacted by the Worc. Business Journal for an article on loneliness; Channel 3 TV continues to cover events at the center.

Patty reported on recent and upcoming programs, such as Dementia Friendly Worcester, Earth Day, Community Gardens and the volunteer recognition programs to which Commission members were invited. Updates were given on Senior Aide staffing, security and building items. A tentative ground breaking is scheduled for June 3rd.

Lindita reported on outreach to the Worcester Housing Authority elder buildings, the upcoming health and safety fair as well as the evidence based Tai Chi program she is teaching.

Ron reported on the activities of the Friends of Worcester Senior Center, including the sale of Friends shirts to raise funds.
