34 Longfellow Road – Special Permit and Variance: Upon a motion by Thomas Hannigan and seconded by Matthew Armendo, the Board voted unanimously to deny the requested Special Permit (Variance was denied 10/16/00).

101 Highland Street – Special Permits and Variance: Upon a motion by Thomas Hannigan and seconded by Charles Buffone, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Special Permits and Variance.

Norfolk Street – Administrative Appeal: Upon a motion by Thomas Hannigan and seconded by Charles Buffone, the Board voted unanimously to continue the hearing to November 27, 2000 and requested information from the Law Department.
