Please be advised that the Commonwealth of Massachusetts has planned on moving some state offices to 50 Southwest Cutoff, Worcester, MA. Since my sister owns an abutting property I want to put this statement on record with your office.

Pursuant to the foregoing statement of facts, I have an imputed financial interest under the State Conflict of Interest Law, G.L. c. 268A, §19. As such I cannot and will not participate in my official capacity as an elected city council with respect to any matters involving the relocation of the state Department of Transitional Assistance ("DTA") to 50 Southwest Cutoff, Worcester.

However, as authorized by .L. c. 268A, §17, I can and will represent my own personal point of view in any public discourse concerning the DTA relocation. I will speak strictly on my own behalf and not on behalf of my constituents.

Accordingly, I am submitting this letter to you, Madame City Clerk, so that I may be on record with your office that I have made this acknowledgement of the limitations of my involvement in the DTA relocation matter and to affirm my right of personal participation in that matter. I will furthermore make sure that when I present my point of view, I will first explain that the comments I am about to make are not made in my role as a city councilor but instead constitute a personal opinion.
